

Senator Martins & Department of Financial Services Bring Foreclosure Prevention Program to Hicksville

Senator Jack M. Martins (R-Mineola) and the New York State Department of Financial Services (DFS) recently teamed up to provide services to homeowners facing foreclosure.

Senator Martins arranged for DFS to bring its Mobile Command Center to the Hicksville Library, where trained DFS specialists provided individualized assistance to homeowners in need

As part of the program, DFS staff members met one-on-one with homeowners to assist them in their efforts to obtain loan modifications and other relief; provide information on available federal programs; inform them about their rights and answer questions about the foreclosure process; help them seek resolutions with banks and mortgage servicers; and take complaints about suspected predatory lending or other abuses.
