I want to thank the brave women who courageously stood up to tell their stories of harassment by New York Governor Andrew Cuomo. This is truly a sad day for our state, and it is time for the Governor to do the right thing for the good of New York's future.

Since these troubling allegations were first brought to light, I have supported an independent investigation to uncover the full truth and bring justice for these women. Now
