Here are some facts and history about Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day:

- In 1983, President Ronald Reagan signed a bill which created Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day as a federal holiday. The holiday is celebrated on the 3rd Monday in January each year.
- The holiday is celebrated close to his birthday, which is January 15th.
- It was celebrated in all 50 states for the first time in 2000.
- Since 1996, the Greater Philadelphia King Day of Service has been the largest event in the nation to celebrate Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.
