2013 Family Tax Relief Act

This week, I joined my Senate colleagues to announce the 2013 Family Tax Relief Act. This package of tax relief and reform measures is designed to provide a major economic boost to New York's struggling middle class families.

The plan would increase tax breaks that have not kept pace with inflation, and, in some instances, haven't been adjusted for more than 25 years. The plan also restores the STAR property tax rebate check program to provide real and direct relief to millions of New Yorkers who pay some of the highest property taxes in the country.

The Family Tax Relief Act will give relief to the overburdened middle class families, working men and women, and individuals throughout my district and across New York State.
