## Community Update: 06/27/12



## Dear Neighbor,

With the close of the 2012 Legislative Session, I am proud to share with you some key legislation that will not only have a positive impact on the Rochester region, but New York State as a whole. I was pleased to have the opportunity to <u>address</u> the Senate prior to the close of Session, which was one of the most orderly and successful Sessions in recent history.

Working with Governor Cuomo for the second year in a row we have kept New York moving in a new, stronger, and more positive direction. In addition to reducing taxes and spending – and passing two consecutive on-time budgets – we have also successfully approved a wide array of important new laws over the course of the past two Legislative Sessions. Highlights from the 2012 Legislative Session include:

- <u>Middle-Class Tax Cut</u>: We enacted a \$3.3 billion middle-class tax cut for 4.4 million hardworking, overburdened taxpayers bringing middle-class tax rates to the lowest level in 58 years.
- DNA Databank Expansion: This landmark crime-fighting law, which will help law

- enforcement track down and punish criminals, will carry out the largest expansion of the state's DNA databank since it was first created in 1994.
- <u>I-STOP</u>: This important new law will help save lives, improve public safety, and make New York a national leader in combating prescription drug abuse.
- <u>Domestic Violence</u>: We approved a historic new law to help combat domestic violence - including tough new penalties for offenders, and stronger protections for victims.
