New Law will Notify Women of “Dense Breast Tissue”

On Monday, Governor Cuomo signed legislation to help improve breast cancer detection and prevention by requiring that mammography providers notify patients if they have dense breast tissue. The new law will provide women with important information they need to make decisions regarding their personal health care. Specifically, it will require that every mammography report given to a patient with dense breast tissue inform the women in plain, non-technical language that they have dense breast tissue and recommend a discussion with their physician about the potential benefit of getting further screenings.

As a steadfast supporter of initiatives dedicated to eradicating breast cancer, I am proud to have supported this measure. It is vital that women throughout New York State receive the critical information they need to make well-informed decisions about their health care. Being proactive about breast health care has proven successful in saving countless lives, and that is why I have secured hundreds of thousands of dollars for local organizations – like the [Breast Cancer Coalition of Rochester](#) – to assist women and their families living with this terrible disease. For my efforts, I have been honored to be a recent Chairman of the annual Breast Cancer Education Luncheon hosted by Highland Hospital which is taking a leading role in the early detection and prevention of breast cancer.

According to leading medical studies, breast cancer is four to six times more likely in women with dense breast tissue. In addition, mammograms fail to detect approximately 40-50 percent of tumors in dense tissue because this condition may hide their presence. In spite of those facts, a recent Harris Interactive survey found that 95 percent of women are unaware of their breast density and less than one-in-ten women learn about breast density from their physician.
