Tax Cut and Job Creation Plan

Earlier this week, I along with my colleagues, working in a bipartisan way, enacted a plan that will cut taxes for millions of New Yorkers and help create thousands of new private sector jobs.

Under this Middle Class Tax Cut and Job Creation Plan, approximately 4.4 million middle class taxpayers will receive \$690 million in personal income tax relief, allowing them to save, spend and invest more of their hard-earned money.

After these tax reforms are implemented, middle class taxpayers will see the lowest tax rate in more than 50 years. A portion of small business owners, manufacturers, and farmers will also see their taxes cut.
