Reclaiming an Animal That is at the AC&C Care Center

If you believe that your pet is at our Care Center, you must come personally during business hours. You need to bring the following information with you:

- The animal ID number from our website at <http://www.nycacc.org/>
- Valid governmental approved photo ID
- Proof of current address
- Proof of ownership of your pet, (i.e. vet records, adoption papers, purchase papers, NYC dog license, etc.)
- If you were evicted, bring your eviction paperwork

If your pet is at a Care Center, fees may apply to reclaim your pet. These fees may vary based on the time your pet has been in the Care Center.
