**SENIOR CITIZENS – 1-800-342-9871** — Assistance from the State Office for the Aging for senior citizens with any problem. Call between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., weekdays.

**EMPIRE MEDICARE SERVICES — 1-800-633-4227** — Provides answers to Medicare-related questions. Call between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., weekdays.

**CHILD ABUSE — 1-800-342-3720** — To report cases of child abuse or neglect. Call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

**VETERANS — 1-888-VETS-NYS (1-888-838-7697)** — Provides information on state and federal veterans benefits as well as county telephone numbers for assistance. Call between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

**PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION — 1-800-342-3377** — For **complaints** on utility billings, services, deposits, disconnections and information on hearings. Call between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., weekdays.

**1-800-342-3355** — To meet the **emergency** needs of residential consumers without gas or electric service. Call between 7:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m., weekdays.

**FAMILY VIOLENCE — 1-800-942-6906** — Provides crisis intervention and counseling referrals and information for victims of family violence. Call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
