Senator John Bonacic Invites Nominations for New York State Veterans' Hall of Fame

Senator John Bonacic invited nominations from the 42nd State Senate District of Veterans for induction into the New York State Senate Veterans' Hall of Fame. The online Hall of Fame recognizes New Yorkers whose heroism in the United States Armed Forces is complemented by their service to the community.

Veterans residing in the 42nd State Senate District are eligible to be nominated. The 42nd Senate District includes the following communities: all of Sullivan County; the following Towns in Delaware County: Masonville, Tompkins, Walton, Hamden, Delhi, and Colchester; the following Towns in Orange County: Deerpark, Goshen, Greenville, Hamptonburgh, Minisink, Mount Hope, Tuxedo, Wallkill, Warwick, Wawayanda; Cities of Middletown and Port Jervis; and in Ulster County, the Towns of Denning, Gardiner, New Paltz, Rosendale, Shawangunk, and Wawarsing.

“There is an opportunity to honor the men and women who served in the military to protect our freedom,” said Senator Bonacic. “The Veterans' Hall of Fame recognizes the exceptional commitment and sacrifices of those who helped make our nation and communities a better and safe place.”

The Senate will honor a distinguished veteran from our area and throughout the state at a May 21st Albany ceremony, where each honoree's photograph and biography will become part of a special on-line exhibit which tells the stories of the many contributions Veterans make during and after their time in military service.

The New York State Senate Veterans' Hall of Fame was created to honor and recognize outstanding veterans from the Empire State who have distinguished themselves, both in military and civilian life.

Nominations must be received no later than April 30, 2013.
