Protecting Your Family from Carbon Monoxide

As the colder weather sets in and families spend more time indoors, it is important to be aware of the dangerous effects of Carbon Monoxide. Carbon Monoxide (CO) – an odorless, colorless gas – can cause illness and even death with too much exposure. CO is produced when any fuel such as gas, oil, kerosene, wood, or charcoal is burned, and the gas can build up in enclosed or partially-enclosed spaces, or poorly ventilated areas.

Exposure to CO can cause flu-like symptoms including headache, dizziness, nausea and loss of muscle control. Families can protect themselves from CO by: having a professional check their heating systems, chimneys and vents; test CO detectors; and read and follow manufacturer’s instructions when using space heaters, fireplaces, generators, and other appliances. If appliances are not working properly or are used incorrectly, dangerous levels of CO may result.

I urge families to be wary of Carbon Monoxide and contact their electric supplier with any
