Dear Director Kaminski,

On April 4, 2016, two students suffered injuries and were transported to WCA Hospital in Jamestown by emergency personnel after they were struck by a car at 2:45 p.m. while walking near Falconer Middle-High School around the intersection of East Main Street and East Avenue. Thankfully, their injuries were non-life threatening. However, this serious incident raises compelling safety issues that must be addressed.

Nearly all of the 176 students who attend Falconer Middle-High School walk there. This heavy traffic area is very busy at times when students are coming to and from school. In fact, I have been contacted by local government officials and school personnel who are requesting that a traffic light is installed at the intersection of East Avenue and Route 394.

I am strongly urging the New York State Department of Transportation to conduct a traffic study so that a traffic light may be placed where the crosswalk currently exists. The safety of our children should be the utmost priority, and this hazardous situation must be addressed.

Thank you for your attention to this critical matter. I look forward to your response.
