WHEREAS, The Appalachian trail passes through the Town of Dover,
providing great opportunities to hike and experience nature; and

WHEREAS, Around 8,500 residents call this town home; and

WHEREAS, There are two fire departments in the Town; the Harlem-Metro North line has two stops in Dover; and

WHEREAS, Of historic origin, and remaining fruitful over the ebb and flow of decades of growth and change, the Town of Dover continues to provide the quintessential quality of life for its residents; and

WHEREAS, The residents of the Town of Dover have a bright outlook for the future of their community, which remains a beautiful place in which to live and raise a family; and

WHEREAS, In recognition of the Town of Dover's rich history and enduring contribution to the State of New York, this Legislative Body is proud to pay tribute to this spirited town upon the occasion of its 216th Anniversary; now, therefore, be it
