COMMEMORATING the 50th Anniversary of the SUNY  
Westchester Educational Opportunity Center

WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Westchester Educational Opportunity Center, to be celebrated on Thursday, June 8, 2023, at the Graduation & Completion Ceremony held by SUNY Westchester Community College in Yonkers, New York; and

WHEREAS, Westchester EOC provides access to quality education and serves as the center of influence for training and career development for students and the community; they are committed to fostering the personal growth, intellectual development, and economic independence of students while supporting the economic revitalization and well-being of the community; and

WHEREAS, Westchester EOC's College Prep Academy helps prepare students for the college placement exam, to minimize the number of developmental or remedial classes a student might need once they register for college; furthermore, they provide college tours, workshops, and guidance to help make the transition to higher education easier and more successful; and

WHEREAS, Partnering with well-established and significant employers, other educational institutions and training providers, community-based organizations, and state and local government agencies, Westchester EOC provides internships and externships for their students, offer

customized training, and refer trained and screened candidates for available job openings; and

WHEREAS, Serving as a resource on various workforce development issues in the County, Westchester EOC provides workshops at a variety of public forums and venues relating to public policy, federal legislation, and the needs of underserved populations; and
