WHEREAS, In addition to the skill and devoted service demonstrated by individual firefighters and emergency personnel, the Galway Volunteer Fire Company reflects on their rich history and development of firefighting over the past 100 years at a celebration on Saturday, August 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body cannot express sufficient gratitude to those devoted individuals who recognize that the preservation of life and property is a sacred responsibility and who make that responsibility their own by serving, especially in a volunteer capacity; and
