WHEREAS, Committed to his community, Ray Negron has worked to facilitate hospital visits by Yankee players to terminally ill children and co-founded "Hank's Yanks" with Hank Steinbrenner, a not for profit

youth travel baseball team for underprivileged children; and

WHEREAS, Through his writing, Ray Negrón has continued to be a positive influence on children, publishing several children's books that have been featured on best seller lists and in the National Baseball Hall of Fame, including the 2006 International Children's Book of the Year "The Boy of Steel," "The Greatest Story Never Told: The Babe and Jackie," "One Last Time: Goodbye to Yankee Stadium," and "Yankee Miracles: Life with the Boss and the Bronx Bombers"; and

WHEREAS, In recognition of his impact on his community and on baseball, Ray Negrón has been included as a member of the International Latino Hall of Fame, the Hispanic Heritage Baseball Hall of Fame, the Ted Williams Hall of Fame, the New York State Baseball Hall of Fame, and has been honored by the Department of Homeland Security; and
