Senate Resolution No. 1411

amending Senate Resolution R2864 of 2022  
establishing a plan setting forth an itemized list  
of grantees for a certain appropriation for the  
2022-23 state fiscal year for services and expenses  
of economic development and community services  
organizations. Notwithstanding any other provision  
of law to the contrary, the amounts appropriated  
herein may be sub-allocated or transferred between  
other agencies, including but not limited to, the  
department of economic development, as required by a  
plan setting forth an itemized list of grantees with  
the amount to be received by each, or the  
methodology for allocating such appropriation. Such  
plan shall be subject to the approval of the  
temporary president of the senate and the director  
of the budget and thereafter shall be included in a  
resolution calling for the expenditure of such  
monies, which resolution must be approved by a  
majority vote of all members elected to the senate  
upon a roll call vote

RESOLVED, That pursuant to and as required by money appropriated  
in section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2022 which enacts the aid to  
localities, local assistance account, for services and expenses of  
economic development and community services organizations.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the amounts appropriated herein may be sub-allocated or transferred between other agencies, including but not limited to, the department of economic development. Such funds shall be apportioned pursuant to a plan setting forth an itemized list of grantees with the amount to be received by each, or the methodology for allocating such appropriation. Such plan shall be subject to the approval of the temporary president of the senate and the director of the budget and thereafter shall be included in a resolution calling for the expenditure of such monies, which resolution must be approved by a majority vote of all members elected to the senate upon a roll call vote, in accordance with the following schedule and as adopted by Senate Resolution R2864 of 2022
