WHEREAS, Throughout the war, Quentin Nicastro had a positive attitude, never concerned about anything except fulfilling his duties; and

WHEREAS, In 1972, Quentin Nicastro moved to Lewisboro, New York, and raised three children; and

WHEREAS, With his zest for life, Quentin Nicastro has inspired and enriched the lives of his family and friends through the profound charm and wisdom which come only from a fullness of years; this exceptional centenarian has experienced the incredible joys and sorrows characteristic of, and reserved for, those with the stamina and courage to savor a full life; and

WHEREAS, As Americans, we honor Quentin Nicastro, as well as all the individuals who sacrificially served our country, preserving its freedom, given to us by our founding fathers, and the hope that future generations will remember that gift provided by those who gave everything; and
