WHEREAS, The Men's Cougars worked as a team to achieve 151.5 points by the end of the meet, followed by Hunter College with 114 points; the Women's team finished with 166 points, surpassing Hunter Lehman, York, and CCNY; and

WHEREAS, This win is truly remarkable, as this was the first win for Medgar Evers College athletics since February 26, 2011 when the Medgar Evers Men's Basketball team, won the conference crown; and

WHEREAS, Proudly donning the school's colors of black and gold, family, friends, and the community at large loyally and enthusiastically supported the Cougars throughout their journey as they ended their seasons with impressive overall records; and

WHEREAS, In a sport such as track and field, which demands athletic prowess, speed and agility, Head Coach Hugh Reid and his expert coaching staff worked hard to hone the skills of these championship teams, teaching these outstanding athletes lessons which will prove invaluable both on and off the track; and
