WHEREAS, Yankasa also has a council of elders and Islamic teachers who provide marriage counseling and many other social services; and

WHEREAS, When a community member falls ill, the organization's members band together to provide help in a variety of capacities, and in unfortunate cases of a death, they contribute to burial services; and

WHEREAS, Yankasa Association of New York pridefully hosts many events, such as the Islamic Naming Ceremonies, a "social gathering to bless the kid, pray islamically" and generally celebrate the child and his or her families; and

WHEREAS, Yankasa Association of New York stands on the threshold of tomorrow, prepared to meet the challenges of the coming decades while retaining that spiritual resolve which characterizes its past; and

WHEREAS, It is the custom of this Legislative Body to take note of enduring religious institutions and to bring such institutions to the

attention of the people of this Empire State; now, therefore, be it
