WHEREAS, Officer Jonathan Diller served the New York City Police Department as a member of the Patrol Borough Queens South Community Response Team with dedication, loyalty, and compassion, earning the admiration, affection, and esteem of his brothers and sisters in blue; and

WHEREAS, A true hero, Officer Jonathan Diller is survived by his beloved wife, Stephanie; and their young son, Ryan; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jonathan Diller's infinite selflessness and benevolence will shine on through his family's vivid and happy memories; his life of service and strength will forever serve as a beacon of love, light and hope to the countless lives he touched; and

WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of compassion, Officer Jonathan Diller leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all who were privileged to have known and loved such an amazing man; he will be deeply missed and truly merits the grateful tribute of this Legislative Body; now, therefore, be it
