


Mid Hudson News: Senator Mayer hosts food drive in partnership with Feeding Westchester

WHITE PLAINS – Senator Shelley B. Mayer (D, Westchester) is partnering with Feeding Westchester to sponsor a food donation drive in honor of Hunger Action Month, which will continue through Monday, September 30th with five drop-off locations throughout Westchester County.
