MEMORIALIZING Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim January 26, 2025, as the 212th Anniversary of Juan Pablo Duarte Day in the State of New York

WHEREAS, Juan Pablo Duarte, along with Francisco Del Rosario Sanchez and Ramon Matias Melia, formed La Trinitaria, a secret organization that initiated the movement for the independence of the Dominican Republic; and

WHEREAS, During the month of January 2025, Dominican Nationals and Dominican Americans from throughout the Dominican Republic and the United States will celebrate the independence of the Dominican Republic; and

WHEREAS, Each year, this auspicious occasion is celebrated and

provides an opportunity for all people to reflect upon the rich history of the Dominican Republic and the many contributions of Latin Americans to our country as well as the world; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body to recognize the great contributions which Dominicans, such as Juan Pablo Duarte, have brought to our State and Nation; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to memorialize Governor Kathy Hochul to proclaim January 26, 2025, as the 212th Anniversary of Juan Pablo Duarte Day in the State of New York; and be it further
