Albany--Senator Jim Tedisco (R,C-Ballston Lake) and Assemblywoman Mary Beth Walsh (R,C-Ballston) today proudly honored at the state Capitol the 2024 New York State Class B Champion Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake (BHBL) Field Hockey Team.

The BHBL Spartans defeated Lakeland High School in a *3-0 victory to win the state championship on November 17*, 2024 at Arlington High School in Lagrangeville, New York.

Head coached by Kelly Vrooman, the Spartans ended their season with an undefeated 21-0 overall record.

Since 2012, the program has won 11 sectional titles, four consecutive Suburban Council Championship titles, six New York State Final Four appearances and now, two NYS Class B Championship titles.

Senator Tedisco and Assemblywoman Walsh presented the teams with copies of legislative resolutions they passed in each house commemorating the BHBL team's state championship season.
