WHEREAS, A sport such as wrestling, which requires skill, dedication, strength, and athletic prowess, is also a healthy way for young individuals to channel and release negative emotions such as anger, while building important interpersonal relationships with their peers and coach; and

WHEREAS, Coach Heather Niver and all the outstanding athletes on the Syracuse Central School District Girls Wrestling Team have clearly utilized dedication, determination, and teamwork in providing a lasting contribution to the spirit of excellence which is a tradition of their school; now, therefore, be it
