Hank Grishman has proudly served as a superintendent of schools across
multiple New York districts; and

WHEREAS, During Hank Grishman's productive tenure, the students and staff of the Jericho School District have earned numerous national accolades, including National Merit Scholarships, Siemens and INTEL Science Competition awards, as well as various other distinctions of excellence; and

WHEREAS, Under his steady leadership, Hank Grishman has ensured that the Jericho School District has been consistently ranked as one of the top open enrollment public schools in the United States across multiple trusted polls and evaluations; and

WHEREAS, Always devoted to the success of Jericho students and staff, Hank Grishman oversaw the expansion of academic course offerings, the increase of co-curricular and athletic programs, and the extension of both the school day and the academic year to better serve the needs of all students; and
