"Her lifetime of service as an educator and advocate for children has left a profound impact on countless lives in our community. Mrs. Lee has been widely recognized for her work, receiving numerous local and state awards, including the New York State African Studies Association Educators Award and honors from Cornell University's Africana Studies Center. She was recently honored with a mural at Beverly J. Martin Elementary School for her extraordinary commitment to children.
