The event successfully provided free breast cancer screenings to 20 women in the community, emphasizing the importance of early detection and accessible healthcare services. The mobile mammogram unit arrived at the district office during the morning hours to provide free breast cancer screening services to women of all ages. The program worked to educate people about breast health while making essential screening tests accessible to women who need them.

Senator Addabbo expressed his satisfaction about the numerous women who actively pursued their health needs during this day. "Through regular screenings women can receive life-saving benefits and I feel proud to collaborate with the American-Italian Cancer Foundation for delivering essential healthcare services to our community," Senator Addabbo said.
