Sam Sutton Sworn in as State Senator for the 22nd District

Senator Sutton's Swearing In Ceremony

(Albany, NY) — Sam Sutton was officially sworn in today as the New York State Senator representing Senate District 22, which covers the Brooklyn neighborhoods of Midwood, Flatbush, Borough Park, Marine Park, Gerritsen Beach, and Sheepshead Bay. Senator Sutton won a special election held on May 20, 2025, to fill the seat left vacant by now New York City Councilmember Simcha Felder. The ceremony, held at the New York State Capitol, was attended by family, friends, and colleagues. The oath of office was administered by Senator Sutton's son-in-law, Rabbi Joseph Beyda, in the State Senate Chamber.

Senator Sutton was sworn in using a special copy of the Keter Aram Soba, a Bible which was safeguarded by the Jewish community of Aleppo, Syria for many centuries. The use of this Bible is a tribute to the Senator's deep commitment to his traditional values and reflects his dedication to community service. Senator Sutton is thankful to Congregation Shaare Zion of Brooklyn, NY, of which he has been a member since childhood, for loaning this special artifact for this purpose.

"I am honored and humbled to take the oath of office for the 22nd State Senate District and I thank the voters for placing their trust in me to serve them in the State Senate," said **Senator Sutton**. "I am eager to get to work, to listen, and to tirelessly advocate for the needs of our community here in Albany. We have much to accomplish, and I look forward to fighting for our community's priorities and for the residents of the 22nd District."
