On February 11, Senator Serrano cosponsored Arts Day 2025 in Albany alongside Assembly Member Ron Kim, who serves as the Chair of the Assembly Committee on Tourism, Parks, Arts, and Sports Development. The event brought together arts advocates and leaders from various regions of New York State, all emphasizing the critical role the arts play in enriching communities and driving economic growth.

Discussions centered on three key areas:

As the New York State legislature worked on shaping the SFY 2025-26 budget, Arts Day served as a platform for advocating for the arts, as well as a crucial reminder of the vital impact that a substantial investment in the arts and culture sector has on the state's economy, community cohesion, and educational enrichment.
