for Stellaris Health Network, the not-for-profit parent corporation for four Westchester community hospitals, including Lawrence Hospital Center, Northern Westchester Hospital, Phelps Memorial Hospital, and White Plains Hospital Center along with several other subsidiaries; and WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the well-being and vitality of their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to excellence certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
