WHEREAS, Elmina Parris proclaims that the secret to living up to 100 years of age is growing up on a diet of "duff" which has enabled her to be as strong as she is today; and

WHEREAS, Encountering difficulties throughout her life, Elmina Parris was raised to have a contented mind, a strong love of God and family, and to do well; and

WHEREAS, With her throughout have been her three children, 19 grand-

children, 31 great-grandchildren and seven great-great grandchildren, all of whom feel privileged to be a part of her life and rejoice in her achievements; and
