WHEREAS, Currently, Chanatry's Market on French Road, run by the descendants of Michael Chanatry, stands as the sole location of this historic, family owned business; and

WHEREAS, Today, Chanatry's Market proudly carries out its commitment of personal service and exceptional quality and eagerly looks forward to serving the community of Utica, New York for another century to come; and

WHEREAS, It is with great pleasure that this Legislative Body acknowledges the success of this exceptional business and recognizes its contribution to the local and State economies, fully confident that it will continue to enjoy the sparkling successes it has experienced thus far; now, therefore, be it
