WHEREAS, After being presented the Cup, Noah Delaney was at a loss for words, only talking about how everything that happened was awesome, especially because it meant so much to his father as well; as part of winning the contest, he was able to bring the Stanley Cup back to his house for the day; in addition to having the Cup for a day, he received two tickets to Game 1 of the Stanley Cup finals at the end of May; and WHEREAS, Noah Delaney's story will also be told on national television during Game 1 of the Stanley Cup finals, and played throughout the arena during the game; and
