WHEREAS, The celebration of the 175th Anniversary of the Town of South Bristol will begin at the Town Hall open house from 9am to 12 noon on Saturday, March 9, 2013; town officials will be on hand along with a historical display; in addition, the town highway department will display its newer equipment in the parking lot; and WHEREAS, On May 18, 2013, a formal, gala dinner is planned at the Cummings Nature Center as part of the town's 175th Anniversary Celebration; on July 28, 2013, a picnic is planned at Bristol Mountain; and WHEREAS, In addition, on October 5, 2013, the annual Hops dinner at the old Grange will be an integral part of the 175th Anniversary Celebration of the Town of South Bristol; and
