Rockville Centre school system, received her Bachelor of Arts degree from Colby College, where she was elected to Phi Beta Kappa; and WHEREAS, Furthermore, Doris Kearns Goodwin earned her Ph.D. in Government from Harvard University, and has been a Woodrow Wilson Fellow and a White House Fellow; and

WHEREAS, With her nationally acclaimed writing accomplishments and her deep connections to Rockville Centre, Doris Kearns Goodwin is the quintessential selection for Gala Honoree; and
