WHEREAS, Tomasz Marian Kaczowka is survived by his mother, Janina, his father, Marian, and his older twin brothers, Dariusz and Greg; and

WHEREAS, The West Webster Volunteer Firemen's Association is an extended family and will always remember this outstanding young man for the hard work and dedication he showed the fire company as well as the

community, but most importantly, for his quality of character; and
