WHEREAS, A man who had a deep love for life and his family, Josef Kucher loved to sit on the porch and read the Sunday paper, walking and gardening; he was a master story teller of his life's many adventures, and among other things, he was always the life of the party; and WHEREAS, Josef Kucher's commitment to excellence, and his spirit of humanity, carried over into all fields of enterprise, including charitable and civic endeavors; and

WHEREAS, Predeceased by his loving son, Joseph, as well as 13 brothers and sister, Josef Kucher is survived by his wife, Hannelore; his son, Michael (Keri); his sister, Barbara; three beautiful grandchildren, Caroline, Kate and Patrick; as well as several nieces and nephews; and WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit, imbued with a sense of compassion, and comforted by a loving family, Josef Kucher leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all he served and befriended; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That this Legislative Body pause in its deliberations to mourn the death of Josef Kucher, distinguished citizen and devoted member of his community; and be it further RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution, suitably engrossed, be transmitted to the family of Josef Kucher.
