WHEREAS, Under the luminous direction of President Daniel Berry, Ulrich Planfiling has, over the years, refined their original design to incorporate sheet metal and expanded their product line adapting to changes in the business world; today, they offer filing systems that are water and fire resistant, units with wheels, and custom manufactured steel office furniture, thus remaining a leader in the filing industry; and
