WHEREAS, It is crucial that individuals with developmental disabilities have access to the resources which allow them to live secure, fulfilling lives, including education, housing, employment, and recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, The ARC of Livingston-Wyoming, AlleganyArc, The ReHabilitation Center, The Resource Center, and Aspire of Western New York are among the many tremendous organizations across the State that provide quality service for those with developmental disabilities by ensuring that they are person-centered, effective and efficient; and WHEREAS, Opportunities for citizens with developmental disabilities to live as independently and productively as possible must be fostered throughout New York; now, therefore, be it
