Giasullo is board certified in urology and is a National Board of Medical Examiners diplomate; he is extremely active in his professional community, serving as a member of a number of medical societies including the Association of Concerned Medical Professionals, a non-profit organization which cares for patients who do not qualify for any type of medical insurance; and

WHEREAS, Furthermore, Dr. Michael D. Giasullo is a member of the Bay Ridge Medical Society, Brooklyn Long Island Urologic Society, Kings County Medical Association, American Medical Association and the American Urological Association; in 2014, he was honored by the Italian American Federation as Man of the Year; and
