WHEREAS, Sharon King has received both statewide as well as national attention for her distinguished efforts; she is the proud mother of two daughters and enjoys hiking, traveling, camping, and kayaking; and

WHEREAS, Rare indeed is the impressive dedication shown by an individual for the benefit of others which this remarkable woman has displayed throughout her life; and
