WHEREAS, Founded on July 15, 1919, the National Federation of Business and Professional Women's Club is a bi-partisan organization which fosters the success of working women; throughout the years, three major issues shaped the BPW's agenda including: elimination of sex discrimination in employment, the principle of equal pay, and the need for a comprehensive equal rights amendment; and

WHEREAS, Today, BPW promotes full participation, equity, and economic self-sufficiency for working women through advocacy, education, and information; its objectives include: elevating the standards for women in business and the professions, promoting the interest of business and professional women, bringing a spirit of cooperation among businesses and professional women of the United States, and extending opportunities to business and professional women through education along the lines of industrial, scientific, and vocational activities; and
