WHEREAS, This brave soldier was the recipient of many awards and accolades for this exceptional military service including the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with one Bronze Service Star, Naval Reserve Meritorious Service Medal with one Bronze Service Star, Armed Forces Reserve Medal with Hour Glass Device, and the Meritorious Unit Commendation Ribbon; and

WHEREAS, In addition, Ralph LeBarron received the esteemed Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal with 1960 Device; and

WHEREAS, Residents of this great State must never forget the courage with which these men and women served their country, and must recognize that no greater debt is owed than that owed to those who gave their lives for their beloved Nation and to those who continue to be missing

in action; and
