WHEREAS, Christine Riederer's bands have consistently received top honors at music competitions and festivals; and

WHEREAS, An outstanding performer, Christine Riederer has played with the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra, Erie County Wind Ensemble, and the Buffalo Silver Cornet Band, as well as the Clarence, Amherst, and Cheektowaga Symphonies; she has also played various shows at Shea's, Artpark and the Riviera Theatre; and
