WHEREAS, On February 21, 2015, Alan Sweet braved fire and danger to attempt rescue of domestic violence victims advocate Shannon Pepper

after flames erupted from Erin's Isle Apartments in Cuba, New York; and
WHEREAS, For his heroic actions, Alan Sweet was awarded the Cuba Fire
Department's Fireman of the Year Award; and

WHEREAS, Special recognition should be given to those who work so
assiduously for the betterment of their communities, and they should be
acknowledged publicly for their heroic actions as firefighters in this
great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
