WHEREAS, In the spirit of Lark Street, Victoria Lamas met some of the most amazing friends, who would do anything for her; and

WHEREAS, The Lark Street Business Improvement District recognizes the achievements of Victoria Lamas and has posthumously honored her tireless efforts to keep vibrancy along Albany's "village in the city"; and

WHEREAS, Victoria Lamas leaves behind her adoring parents; her loving older brothers, Celes, and Ben and his wife Rebecca; her loving older sister, Yoly and her husband Joseph, as well as many loving nieces, nephews, cousins, grandmother and other relatives, and countless friends; and

WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of
