Larkin Announces \$20,000 For Braeside Camp

Senator Bill Larkin (R-C, Cornwall-on-Hudson) today announced he has secured a \$20,000 state grant for Braeside Children's Camp.

Funding will be used for necessary repairs, renovations and equipment purchases at the camp.

"Each summer, this organization gives children a wonderful camp experience, an experience they might not otherwise have. I fully support the work of Braeside's dedicated counselors and board members. Janet English, a member of Braeside Camp's Board of Directors, said, "The camp brings such joy to the lives of these children, a time of happiness they will remember all their lives."

The not-for-profit summer camp located in Middletown serves underprivileged children ages 7-11 in Orange County. Braeside hosts 160 sleep-away campers and 60 day-campers each summer. Children who qualify based on economic need are eligible to attend the camp for free.
