ISSUE: DMV (DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES)

Average vehicle registration fee went from \$44 for two years to \$105 for drivers living in the MTA region.

Driver's license renewal fees went from \$50 for an eight-year renewal to \$80.50 in the MTA region.

Trailer registration now costs \$42.50 on average, up from \$34.

Taxi registration fees, on average, went from \$48 to \$60.

Average bus registration fees rose from \$73 to \$91.25.

Motorcycle registration is now \$17.50, up from \$14.

All-terrain vehicle registration increased from \$10 to \$12.50.

Average motorboat registrations rose from \$40 to \$50.

Fees also increased to re-register vehicles, register custom vehicles and make photocopies of motor vehicle documents.
