Buffalo, NY- New York State Senator Antoine M. Thompson (D- Parts of Erie & Niagara Counties), Chair of the Senate's Environmental Conservation Committee, announced the public hearing schedule to solicit input and obtain feedback from the public on water quality in New York State.

"Through these hearings we seek to improve the way we protect our fresh water resources and New Yorkers' health. We are looking for input on all issues impacting water quality, including sewage treatment, drinking water quality, wastewater infrastructure funding, storm water infrastructure, availability of adequate supplies of fresh water, pharmaceuticals in the water supply, and beach closings." stated Thompson
